



City Authorizes Additional Leaf Pickup Service for THIS WEEK

As a service to residents, between October and February, the City is pleased to pick-up fallen leaves raked or blown the curb **every other week**.

Given the amount of leaves currently in the right of way, the City is authorizing an additional leaf pickup this week by working overtime. The special leaf pickup for this week will begin tomorrow (Tuesday, Nov. 28, 2017) and continue through this Saturday (Dec. 2, 2017). On each day, we will start around 7:30 am and work until dusk (approximately 5:30 pm).

Next week (the week of Dec. 4th) is the normal scheduled pickup. Thereafter, the schedule of City sanitation services is shown in the table below with x's.

* The sanitation schedule is subject to change due to weather and some official holidays.

If you blow or rake leaves during weeks when the leaf vacuum truck is not in service, leaves must be containerized or bagged in brown paper bags for pickup by the City's contract service provider, Advanced Disposal Services, on your trash collection day. The brown paper bags for fallen leaves are usually available for purchase at hardware type stores.

Please do not blow leaves in the street/public right of way. Leaves should be blown only inside the edge of your yard at the curb.
