

**Called Council Meeting

Council Member Lowe was absent.

The Mayor called the meeting to order and explained that the purpose of the called meeting was to discuss pay raises.

Council Member Hadden asked Acting Chief McElroy if the current job descriptions for the Police Department were sufficient for the Merit Raise System.

Acting Chief McElroy stated that he had been pushed to develop the job descriptions and the Police Department had done the best that they could.

Council Member Hadden stated that she would be glad to set up a committee to review the job descriptions or have the Carl Vinson Institute of Government write the job descriptions for the City of Doraville at a cost of \$9,800.00.

Council Member Pittman stated that she had looked at the job descriptions and thought that they were pretty good.

The City Clerk stated that all Council Members had been given a copy of the job descriptions and that the job descriptions had been adopted at a prior Council Meeting.
