The meeting was called to order by Mayor Jenkins.

The minutes of June 21, 2004 were read with a motion and second to approve. The motion carried unanimously.

Mr. Kunchul Pak came before the council to discuss his taxi business. Mr. Pak wanted to get a limousine license in lieu of a regular taxi permit. Mr. Pak was advised the taxi regulations will be enforced as written in this situation.

Ms. Inson Park came to ask for a rezoning on the property located at 3921 Flowers Road. The property is owned by the Sam and Molly Portis. Previous discussions have been held on re-zoning this property. Ms. Park was advised to obtain letters from the adjoining property owners and set up an appointment with the City Attorney to best determine the re-zoning for the property. After this task is completed Ms. Park may request to come before the council for a rezoning consideration at that time.

Mayor Jenkins asked for an extension on the tree cutting moratorium until September. Additional discussion will be held in the interim to clarify the tree cutting ordinance. Consensus of the council was to extend the tree cutting moratorium.

Councilwoman Hadden brought up ordinance 04-18 for the first reading. Ordinance 04-18 has been termed Offenses against Property, rather than Criminal Trespass. The offences against property is more comprehensive in its enforceability. This was the first reading of the ordinance.

Mayor Jenkins said the 2004 GMA convention went well and asked each council member to comment of their experience with the conference. All the comments were positive and each said they had gained knowledge in the various areas presented at the convention.

July 6, 2004

Chief King reported on the statistics on the number of calls and crime statistics for the areas which are identified by zones in the city.

Motion was made by Councilman Roach for the approval of the payment of the bills. There was no second motion. Therefore the bill payment was not approved.

Attorney Powell presented ordinance 04-017 for second reading. Motion was made by Councilman Lang and seconded by Councilwoman Hadden to adopt ordinance 04-017. The motion passed unanimously.
