The meeting was called to order by Mayor Jenkins.

The Mayor brought before the Council a bid that arrived this day from Volvo and GMC Trucks of Atlanta for the Chipper Truck. Since the bid was received timely, he recommended that a councilmember open the sealed bid for review. It appearing that the bid from Volvo and GMC Trucks of Atlanta was the least expensive. A motion was made by Councilman Anavitarte to accept the bid, seconded by Councilwoman Hadden. The motion carried unanimously.

Next order of business was the Stormwater Management Contract with DeKalb County. The Mayor indicated that there will be a meeting held on August 10th to help determine how many City's will be involved. Councilwoman Hadden moved to table this item until after the meeting on the 10th, seconded by Councilman Roach. The motion carried unanimously.

The final order of business was the Sign Ordinance. Attorney Powell discussed that he had met with Mr. David Chesnut and other representatives regarding the signs to be displayed on the Hennessy property. All representatives agreed to comply with the City's sign ordinance and that any issue with Hennessy are contractual with the developer and Brand Smart and do not involve the City. Mr. Chesnut indicated that a double faced billboard (14' x 48') has been applied for and Attorney Powell informed him that the billboard would not fit with the City ordinance.

There being no further business the meeting was adjourned.
