

**Called Council Meeting  
City of Doraville  
Minutes  
November 20, 2004  
10:00 p.m.**

Mayor Jenkins called the meeting to order.

Mayor Pro-tem Lang was absent.

The City Clerk opened the bids for the construction of the Police Department wall. Bids are as follows:

Payne Construction, Inc.	\$110,353.00
Georgia Retaining Walls	\$348,502.00
TriStar of America	\$170,419.00
Husky Foundations	\$135,145.00

Council Member Hadden made the motion to accept the bid from Payne Construction for \$110,353.00 on the following conditions:

1. That Payne Construction, Inc. start and complete the wall immediately. The City would be willing to give Payne Construction, Inc. a 2 to 3 week leeway depending on the weather. Bid states a duration time of 3 months.
2. Is the bid of \$110,353.00 the total price? Notes in the bid state that the square footage of wall will be quantified in the estimate and verified against billing.
3. Is the fence at the top of the wall included in the bid?

Council Member Anavitarte seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Council Member Lowe and Council Anavitarte volunteered to represent the City of Doraville on the Mitigation Advisory Council. Mayor Jenkins will also serve on the Mitigation Advisory Council.

Council Member Hadden made the motion to give each employee a net Christmas bonus of \$50.00. Council Member Anavitarte seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Council Member roach made the motion to eliminate the December 20, 2004 Regular Council meeting. Council Member Hadden seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Mayor Jenkins stated that it had been the practice to give each retiree a reception. Mayor Jenkins stated that Council Member Roach would be retiring at the end of December, and Maintenance Worker Buice would be retiring at the end of November.

Council Member Hadden made a motion to continue with the retiree reception and allocate \$300.00 for the reception. Council Member Weese seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Council Member Hadden stated that she would like for the Council Members to present their Goals and Objectives for the City of Doraville for 2005.

The City Attorney was instructed to draft a letter to Waste Management stating that the City of Doraville would be bidding out garbage pick up service. The Waste Management contract is up in 2005.

A work session is set for December 2, 2004 at 10:00 a.m.

Council Member Lowe stated that Hightower School had appointed the Salvation Army to choose the needy families for the canned goods collected by the school.

Mayor Jenkins adjourned the meeting.
