SUMMARY OF MOTIONS

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1 A motion was made by Councilmember Bates to approve
the meeting minutes for November 3, 2008 and November
2 7, 2008. The motion was seconded by Councilmember
Pittman. The motion passed for November 3, 2008
3 meeting unanimously. The motion passed for November
7, 2008 meeting by 5-1 vote, with one dissenting vote
4 by Councilmember Spangler.

5
A motion was made by Councilmember Pittman to extend
6 business license moratorium until December 1, 2008, in
order to allow staff to complete work assigned
7 underneath the original moratorium. The motion was
seconded by Councilmember Spangler. The motion passed
8 by unanimous vote.

9
A motion was made by Councilmember Bates to invite Pam
10 Helton of GMA to Council meeting on December 1, 2008,
in order to discuss the collection agency available
11 through GMA in regard to collecting delinquent City
accounts. The motion was seconded by Councilmember
12 Alexander. The motion passed by unanimous vote.

13
A motion was made by Councilmember Fleming to
14 authorize up to \$40,000 for purchase of additional
servers from Dell, a GSA vendor, in addition to the
15 Police Department Contribution from asset forfeiture,

16 for backup and network storage of digital videos from
17 police vehicles. The motion was seconded by
18 Councilmember Roche. The motion was passed by
19 unanimous vote.

20 A motion was made by Councilmember Roche to accept the
21 I.T. contract from MIS. The motion was seconded by
22 Councilmember Spangler. The motion passed by a vote
23 of 4-2, with dissenting votes by Councilmember
24 Alexander and Councilmember Bates.

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4 A motion was made by Councilmember Roche for MIS to
5 resolve any software licensing issues and to verify
6 that there is no unlicensed software on City
7 computers. The motion was seconded by Councilmember

10 A motion was made by Councilmember Bates to change the
11 name of the Doraville Maintenance Department to
12 Doraville Public Works Department. The motion was
13 seconded by Councilmember Pittman. The motion carried
14 5-1, with one dissenting vote by Councilmember
15 Spangler.

16 A motion was made by Councilmember Bates to adopt
17 proposed policies on Council agenda format, due date,
18 documentation, sunset provision, public comment
19 format, meeting ground rules. The motion was seconded
20 by Councilmember Spangler.

21 The motion was then amended to state that the
22 policies will be enacted through amending applicable
23 ordinances.

24 The motion was then withdrawn.

25 A motion was made by Councilmember Bates to have
Attorney Weed review proposed policies on Council
agenda format, et cetera, and issue a memo regarding
what can be handled as a policy vis-a-vis an
ordinance. The motion was seconded by Councilmember
Roche. The motion passed by unanimous vote.

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19 A motion was made by Councilmember Fleming to pass
 resolution regarding clarifying the voting results of
 annexation referendum. The motion was seconded by
 20 Councilmember Pittman. The motion passed 5-1, with
 one dissenting vote by Councilmember Spangler.

22 A motion was made by Councilmember Bates to move
 forward with City-initiated rezoning on three
 23 properties which are warehouses currently in R-1
 zoning: 6477, 6479 and 6481 Peachtree Industrial
 24 Boulevard. The motion was seconded by Councilmember
 Alexander. The motion passed by unanimous vote.
