8 passed 4-3, with Mayor Jenkins voting and with
9 dissenting votes from Councilmembers Fleming, Roche
10 and Spangler.
- 11 A motion was made by Councilmember Bates to issue an
12 RFP for IT services for City of Doraville. The motion
13 was seconded by Councilmember Alexander. The motion
14 was defeated by a 2-4 vote, with Councilmembers
15 Fleming, Pittman, Roche and Spangler dissenting.
- 16 A motion was made by Councilmember Roche to table the
17 accounting and IT services contracts until further
18 discussion and possible contracts. The motion was
19 seconded by Councilmember Fleming. The motion was
20 passed by unanimous vote.
- 21 A motion was made by Councilmember Roche to postpone
22 the second phase of Autumn Park restoration until
23 English Oak Park is complete. The motion was seconded
24 by Councilmember Bates. The motion passed by
25 unanimous vote.
- 26 A motion was made by Councilmember Bates to accept
27 counteroffer from Freeman, Mathis & Gary to produce
28 Doraville employment manual for \$4,500. The motion
29 was seconded by Councilmember Pittman. The motion was
