



FALL 2017 SANITATION SCHEDULE

It is that time of year—tree leaves are turning beautiful colors, but they are also quickly falling to the ground. As a service to residents, between October and February, the City is pleased to pick-up raked fallen leaves at the curb. Curbside leaf pickup is done every other week. The City also does street sweeping and picks up tree limbs, branches and brush, if properly cut to size. We developed a schedule that alternates these services as to not interfere with regular weekly trash pickup days and the best way to utilize effectively the City staff.

To help residents plan their yard “chores”, below is a schedule of the three services shown with an “x” by the week in which the service will be conducted in each of the remaining months of 2017. (A 2018 schedule will be published soon.)

Please note the following about each service:

- **Clamp Truck** The clamp truck picks up tree limbs, branches, and brushes. These items must be placed at curb in separated piles and all limbs/trees larger than 6 dbh (diameter at breast height) must be cut into length not longer than 5 feet.

- **Leaf/Vacuum Truck** Between October and February of each year, if leaves are left for curbside pickup, the fallen leaves must be kept separated from other yard debris for pickup at curbside by the City’s leaf vacuum equipment. During the remainder of the year March through September, leaves must be containerized or bagged in brown bags for pickup by the City’s contract service provider, Advanced Disposal Services, on your trash

collection day.

- **Street Sweeper** In order to allow the street sweeper to access your street, please avoid parking your vehicle on the street during the day(s) of the weeks the street sweeper
- The street sweeper and the clamp truck are also further assigned the day(s) within the designated weeks when the equipment will be in each neighborhood:
 - Monday (Tuesday, if needed): Northwoods/Carver/Avery Parks/Flowers
 - Wednesday: Oakcliff
 - Thursday (Friday, if needed): Tilly Mill/Winters Chapel
- The Sanitation Schedule is subject to change due to weather and some official holidays. And will be announced on the City’s website
