



LEAF PICK UP REMINDER

Given the weather conditions recently and holidays, we want to remind residents that, between October and February, the City is pleased to pick-up fallen leaves raked or blown the curb **every other week**. To help residents plan their yard “chores”, below is a schedule of the three services shown with an “x” by the week in which the service will be conducted during the remainder of January and February 2018.

- To have leaves ready for pickup, please rake them to the curb – but not onto the street.
- Do not put the leaves by the curb too early because if they blow, it becomes more difficult for the City equipment operator to provide the leaf pickup service.
- If you blow or rake leaves during off weeks when the leaf vacuum truck is not in service, leaves must be containerized or bagged in brown paper bags for pickup by the City’s contract service provider, Advanced Disposal Services, on your trash collection day. The brown paper bags for fallen leaves are usually available for purchase at hardware type stores. This is also the procedure during the remainder of the year. From March through September, leaves must be containerized or bagged in brown bags for pickup on your trash collection day.
- Note: The Sanitation Schedule is subject to change due to weather and some official holidays which will be announced on the City’s website.
