## Tire Amnesty Day Coming Up for Residents of DeKalb County

DeKalb County residents can dispose of car and light-duty truck tires for free from 8 a.m. to 1 p.m. on Saturday, Sept. 14, at either of two locations: the Tax Commissioner's Office parking lot (4380 Memorial Drive, Decatur) or the Seminole Road Landfill (4203 Clevefmont Road, Ellenwood). Proof of county residency may be requested, and each household is limited to a maximum of 10 tires.
