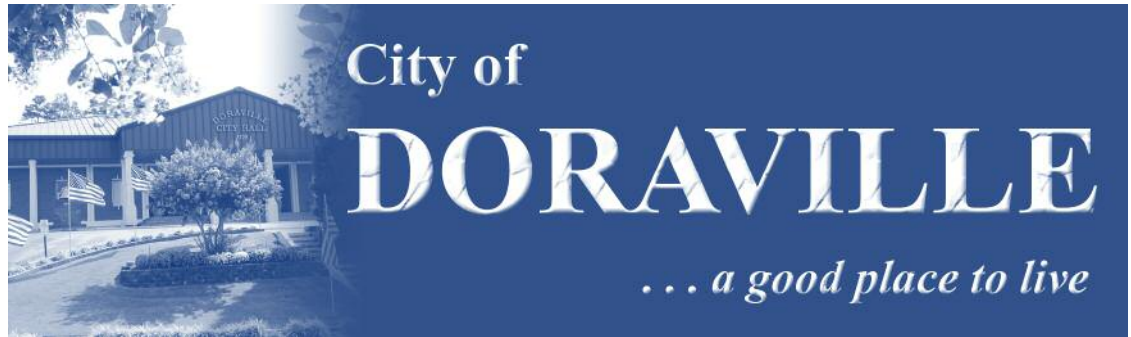

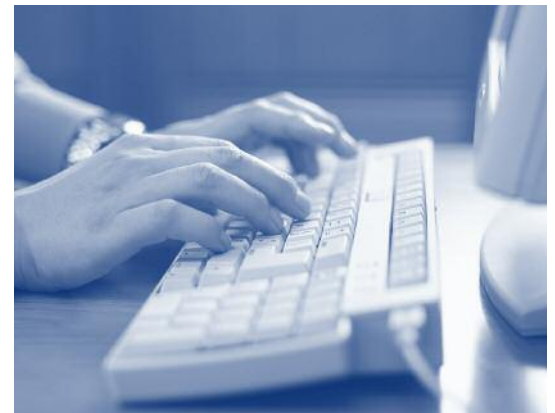

THE CHIEF'S CORNER

The Doraville Police Department is currently accepting applications for the 108th session of the Citizens Police Academy. This will be the third session of the CPA since its inception last year. The program has been a tremendous

success for both the Doraville Police Department as well as the citizens. Because of great demand from previous students, the Academy will now offer a ten-week academic schedule with graduation during week eleven. Classes will be held weekly on Tuesday nights from 6:30 to 9:30pm. Individuals interested in attending the 108th session should fill out an application as soon as possible to ensure a position in the Academy, as we are limited to 25 students. The Doraville Police Department will be holding a Child Safety Seat Check Point. Officers will be checking for proper installation of safety seats in vehicles and will teach drivers how to install them correctly. The event will be held in the parking lot of KMART located at 5597 Buford Hwy. in Doraville on March 29th from 1:00 to 3:00pm. If you plan to attend, we ask that you bring your child safety seat's user manual as well as the owner's manual for your vehicle. Officers will have a current list of safety seat recalls to ensure that your child's seat is a safe one. If you are not able to attend, Officer John Morgan from Doraville Police Department's Traffic Team would like to remind you of some things. Children up to and including age six are required to be in a Child Safety Seat. Booster seats are recommended for children ages seven to twelve years. No child under the age of thirteen should ride in the front seat, and infants in rear-facing safety seats should never be placed in front of an active airbag.

We encourage anyone who uses these seats to stop by and have them checked.

LOST ANIMAL SIGNS

LOST ANIMAL SIGNS

If you have lost your animal as a result of an escape from the yard, house or other containment area, please understand that I am here to assist you in locating your animal. Posting "Lost Animal" signs on telephone poles, speed limit signs or any other City, County or State signs is illegal. Although this may help recover your animal, it defaces public property, creates a safety hazard and is an eyesore for your fellow citizens. It also is a sure way to receive a citation for violating the City of Doraville's sign permit ordinance. Following are the steps you should take to find your lost pet.

Steps to finding a lost animal

Telephone your Doraville Animal Services Department at 770-451-7845;

Telephone your DeKalb County Animal Services Department at 404-294-2996;

Visit these departments in person to check for your animal, and take with you the animal's vaccination papers and any other information available.

Remember that it is *your* responsibility to maintain current vaccinations for your animal under State, County and City laws. The rabies tag that, by law, must be on the animal *at all times* provides Animal Services Departments with information to help locate owners.

Gymnastics and dancing (Ballet & Tap) are taught to children five and older at the Forest Fleming Arena at Honeysuckle Park every Friday Afternoon. Dee Hodges has taught the group for years.

Ms. Hodges also teaches at the Tucker Recreation Center. Every year, the combined classes do three recitals. These are held in late May and early June.

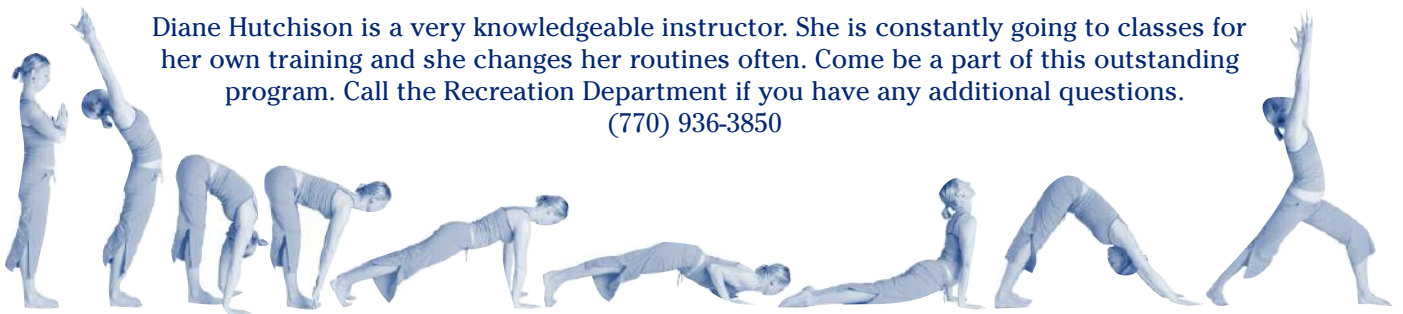
LOW IMPACT AEROBICS
